Job description:

Dispatchers are non-sworn police employees responsible for coordinating a prompt and efficient response to requests for police services by the efficient and diligent manner in which they dispatch messages to field units. They work closely with West Bridgewater police officers in dispatching and directing police resources to general calls for service and emergency matters. Dispatchers will maintain IMC call management systems as well as provide Emergency Medical Dispatch instructions during medical emergencies.

In order to be considered applicants must successfully pass a background investigation as well as be certified in PowerPhone, EMD, CPR, and APCO PST prior to working shifts. Applicants need to be proficient with keyboard/computer skills. Applicants must possess at least a High School diploma or GED equivalent. Experienced dispatchers are preferred but will be trained as needed.
